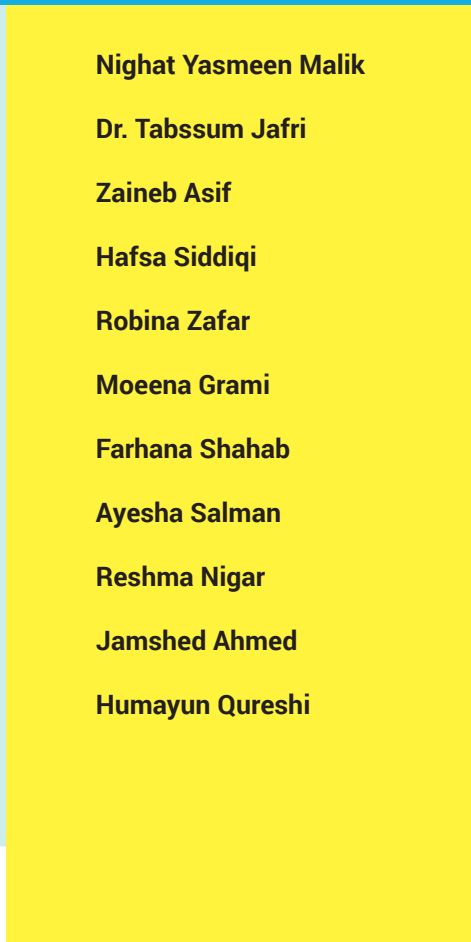

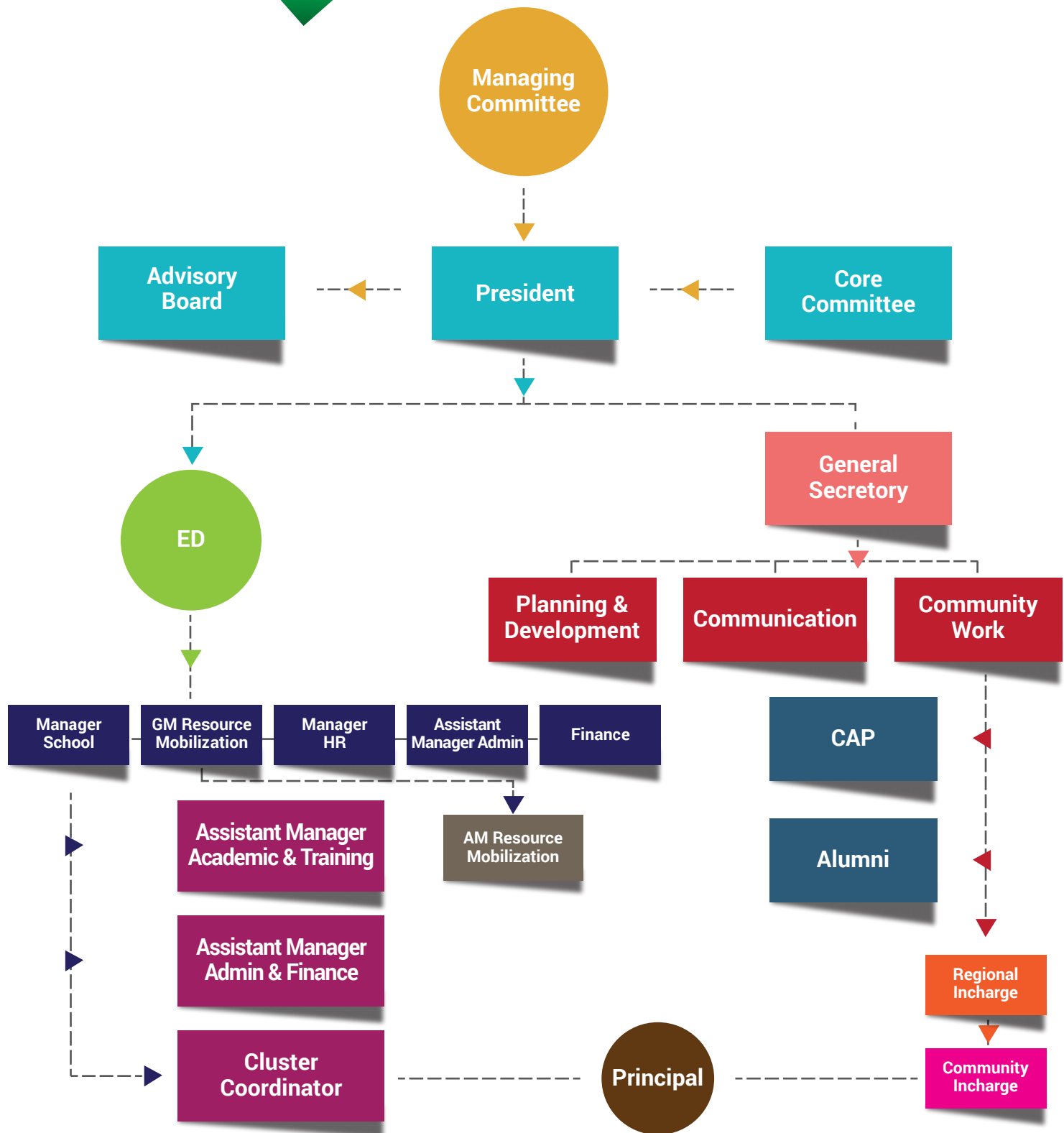

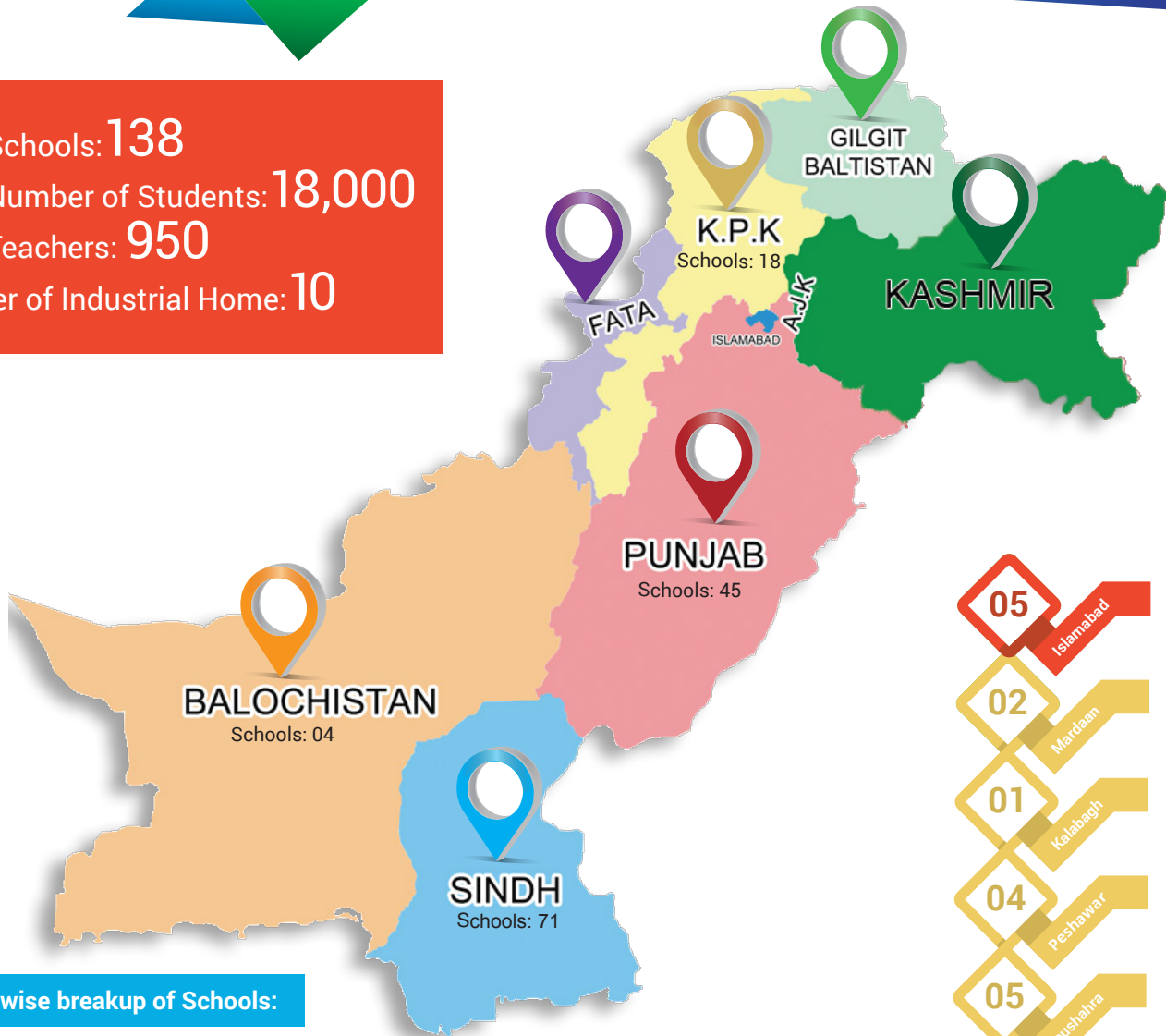


HIERACHY OF SEW

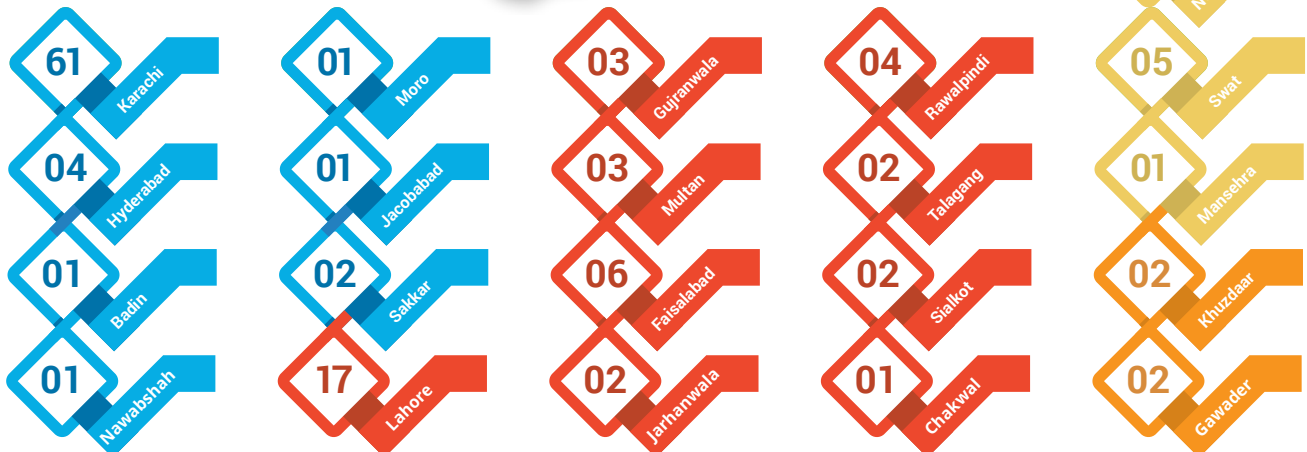


STRENGTH OF Baithak Schools Nationwide

FORMAL AND INFORMAL EDUCATION

ACADEMIC DEVELOPMENT

Academic research through assessment at ground level formulates our unified syllabus, teacher's capacity building program and other supportive publications. This year the revision of curriculum for the next five years has been planned on the basis of this extensive research.



TRAINING AND CAPACITY BUILDING OF TEACHING & NON-TEACHING STAFF



Baithak School Network has local female teachers at its campuses. Most of them start teaching career from Baithak School. To nurture them, BSN derives and conduct capacity building program contentiously. All teachers should attend these basic courses designed specifically in BSN context. We are using the expertise of The Ilm Foundation for ECE while Association for Academic Quality is providing subject training to BSN teachers. Some courses are designed in-house.



VOCATIONAL, COMMUNITY AWARENESS PROGRAM AND CCDP

S.E.W vocational centres offer 3-6 months courses where girls from lower middle / middle class can develop essential skills such as sewing. It helps acquiring skills to utilize as their source of income.

The Vocational Institutions also add value to Baithak School Network by providing school uniforms to the students at Baithak.



COMMUNITY AWARENESS SPECIALLY FOR MOTHERS

The program offers free counselling to mothers of students at Baithak on monthly basis. Cleanliness, health and hygiene and importance of education are focal topics and have evident marks of improved family life.

This year S.E.W. conducted 300 programs in different regions to build better and prosperous community.



COLLABORATED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

In order to connect these underprivileged students with other students of privileged areas, S.E.W conducts collaborative programs with other private educational institutions and encourage their students to visit Baithak Schools. Such programs

help bridge the gaps between students with different mind-sets and are prove to be a great source of learning for new generation.

A group of students from Beacon House School System Mehmoodabad Branch spent their social hours at Baithak School Umer Colony Campus. These senior students interacted with BSN students for art work and plantation activity in school. They both worked out jointly and made the school environment more meaningful and attractive. Beacon House students expressed their from BSN students about patience, hardworking, enthusiasm and respect for teachers. They felt Allah's blessing on them. Now they can visualize and play effective role for less-privileged segment of society.





FRIENDS WITH BOOK PROGRAM

The second phase of library setup started this year after the successful completion of the first phase last year, where new libraries were opened & previous ones reinforced.

16 computer labs were successfully established to equip the children in their I.T skills.



HEALTH AND HYGINE

Due to lack of education and finances in underprivileged areas, most of the people have zero knowledge and understanding to take care of their health and hygiene. S.E.W has always tried to promote the importance of health through events, talks and by providing basic necessities to our students and their families.



FRD KARACHI 2017

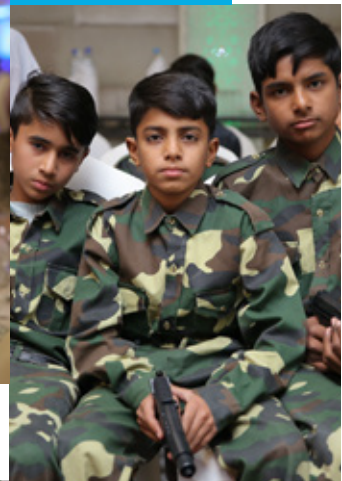

Precisely, to make our nation stronger, richer, healthier and happier, we need to literate Pakistan pooling maximum resources and energies from public and private sector.

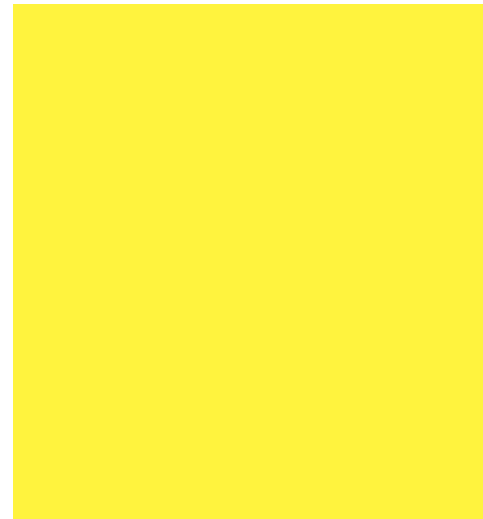
LITERACY DRIVE FOR JIWANI, GWADAR

Like many other marginalized areas of the country, Jiwani is not an exception when we talk about the deplorably low literacy rate of the people in any area.

As per the survey of our team, from a population of 35,000, around 4,500 children are out of school.

Realizing the existing situation, Baithak School Network has established two new schools in the area but this does not fulfill the dire need of the growing population.

To ensure better results, we need to open at least 8 to 10 schools in the area so that need of the entire population could be met at the very outset. We are connected with community and have network of local volunteers who want to join this literacy movement for Jiwani.
